

I.S.E.O. SUMMER SCHOOL 2022/ COVID-19 POLICIES

* In reference to the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022, the I.S.E.O. Institute strictly applies all the rules and restrictions established by the **Italian Ministry of Health** to tackle the Covid-19 pandemic.

* One of the main rules as of December 2021 establishes that only **fully vaccinated** participants who received a vaccine approved by Ema (European Medicine Agency) or equivalent vaccines will be authorized to attend indoor conferences and courses, such as the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022 in presence.

Ema approved vaccines as of December 2021 are **Comirnaty (Pfizer/Biontech), Spikevax (Moderna), Janssen (Johnson & Johnson), Vaxzevria (Astrazeneca) and Nuvaxovid (Novavax)**.

A full list of approved vaccines or equivalent vaccines can be found on the official [statement](#) released on the 23rd September 2021 by the Italian Ministry of Health.

*Before attending the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022, participants will be asked to provide a digital copy of their **green pass** or, if not applicable, a copy of **anti-Covid 19 vaccination record** (written also in English) including the following information: name, surname, date of birth, vaccine's name and batch, vaccination dates, details of the Health Authority releasing the record.

Participants will have to carry a digital or hard copy of the record during their journey and the whole staying in Iseo, and show it anytime it is requested.

*Before attending the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022, participants will be asked to **test negative** to a Covid-19 Pcr test, sending a proof of the results.

*During the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022, participants may be requested to **test against Covid-19**, to guarantee the safety of the whole group of students, speakers and staff.

The I.S.E.O. Institute will organize participants testing (swabs) at its own expenses, with **no additional costs** for the attendees. Results and personal data, including sensitive data, will only be shared with health authorities, if requested.

*During the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022, participants may be asked to **self-isolate** in case of

- symptoms of Covid-19;
- positivity to Covid-19;
- being a contact of a positive person;

*In case of self-isolation or quarantine, participants of the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022 will be charged for **potential additional costs** of accommodation, board and all potential additional costs exceeding what is included in the course fee. I.S.E.O. Institute suggests participants to consider subscribing an **health insurance**.

*In case participants are tested positive during the I.S.E.O. Summer School 2022, they won't be refunded for not taking part into academic and social activities.

*Rules and restrictions may be updated following the **Italian Ministry of Health's** most recent instructions and recommendations. Participants will be promptly informed.
